

**Town of Garfield Regular Meeting  
Tuesday, August 10, 2021 – 6:30 p.m.  
Garfield Town Hall**

Chairman Steve Dickinsen called the Regular Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Garfield to order on Tuesday, August 10, 2021, at 6:45 p.m. in the town hall on Hillcrest Road. Present were Chairman Dickinsen, First Supervisor Lamoine Hanson, Treasurer Clark Walker, and Clerk Ardy Robertson. Second Supervisor Glenn Fremstad absent. Meeting notice verified. Motion to approve agenda made by Dickinsen, seconded by Hanson, and carried. Also in attendance was Lisa Walker, Kevin Anderson, David Call, and Alice Glavin.

Clerk read the minutes of the July 13, 2021 meeting. Motion by Dickinsen, seconded by Hanson, to approve minutes as read. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report of income and expenses for July, 2021 was presented by Walker. Motion to approve treasurer's report made by Hanson, seconded by Dickinsen. Motion carried.

Reconciliation Report presented by Clerk and Treasurer. Motion to accept made by Dickinsen, seconded by Hanson, and carried.

Clerk presented monthly bills for payment. Motion by Hanson, seconded by Dickinsen and carried to pay the bills.

Kevin Anderson was present to discuss a situation on some land he owns on Sand Lane where the ditch has been filled in for parking. The Town of Garfield has not given any permit to allow parking in the town right-of way.

Letter received from town residents about water draining into their driveway from Kay Road. Chairman contacted our town engineer who inspected the area and confirmed our road is constructed properly and it is not possible to prevent water from running into their driveway with the way their driveway is built. He recommended changes to the driveway. Road crew will groom the area following the next rain and will try to prevent too much drainage. The matter will be on next month's agenda.

PASER report information has been received and this will be completed by Delmore Consulting.

Dusty Riders ATV Club has received a grant of \$15,000 to work on trails and approached the town about possible work on parts of the trail within the town.

Dickinsen made a mistake when he was transferring \$50 to a personal account and inadvertently transferred to a town account. He immediately transferred it back out, and into the correct account. He just wanted to note this.

WTA Quarterly meetings in person will resume on Thursday, August 12, in the DHHS Building in Black River Falls, from 7-9 p.m.

Building information application received from Ralph and Angela Voight of Prague, OK for a 30x40 ft. barn to be built on their property at N12641 Rindahl Valley Road in Garfield. \$25 fee received. Motion by Dickinsen, seconded by Hanson to approve. Motion carried.
